

Dependent Resurvey of the Nevada-California State Line.

Chains

Grazing, fair.

S. $47^{\circ} 20'$ E., on the 5th mile between Monuments 79 and 80.

Over mountainous land, through widely scattered timber and a medium dense undergrowth; desc. 70 ft. along a SW. slope to the draw.

3.90 Old road, bears NE. and SW.

8.80 Draw, drains SW.; asc. 350 ft. along a NE. slope to the $\frac{1}{2}$ mile post.

17.10 Old road, bears NW. and SE.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diameter, 26 ins. in the ground to solid rock, and in a mound of stone, for $\frac{1}{2}$ mile cor., with brass cap mkd:

A pinon, 3 ins. diameter, bears N. $84^{\circ} 15'$ E., 18 lks. dist., mkd. BT.A pinon, 3 ins. diameter, bears S. $3^{\circ} 00'$ W., 33 lks. dist., mkd. BT.

Asc. 80 ft. along a N. slope.

41.60 Spur, slopes NE.; desc. 100 ft. along a SE. slope.

60.20 Head of a draw draining NE., asc. 210 ft. along a N. slope.

73.07 Monument 80, a redwood post, 4 ins. square and 5 ft. long, mkd. C on the southwest side, N on the northeast side, and 80 on the northwest side, set in a large mound of stone over a drill hole in a granite block.

Monument is located on a ridge bearing E. and W.

Land, steep mountain slopes, drainage NE.

Soil, gravelly to rocky loam, 3d rate.

Timber, pinon and juniper; undergrowth, sagebrush, yucca and buckbrush, bunch grass.

Grazing, good.

Retracement of the Von Schmidt Survey of the Nevada-California State Line.

Note: The corners found along the Von Schmidt survey were not used for control of the survey lines in T. 6 S., R. 38 E.; Nevada, and the retracement is made for the purpose of defining the location of the Von Schmidt corners and the closing corners established on that line.

Beginning at Mile Post 366, marked by a mound of earth about 16 inches high, surrounded by a circular trench about 10 ft. in diameter, with pits NW. and SE., about
