

RETRACEMENT OF A PORTION OF THE S. BDY. T. 30 N., R. 21 E.

Chains	Offset to the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., and continue west on retracement.
39.88	Fall 11 lks. S. of the cor. of secs. 4, 5, 32, and 33, hereinafter described. The bearing of this half mile, is therefore, N. $89^{\circ}50'$ W., and the distance 39.88 chs. Offset to the sec. cor., and continue west on retracement along the South boundary of sec. 32.
39.90	Fall 11 lks. S. of the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., hereinafter described. The bearing of this half mile, is therefore, N. $89^{\circ}50'$ W., and the distance 39.90 chs. Offset to the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., and continue west, on retracement.
39.84	Fall 12 lks. S. of the cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31, and 32, hereinafter described. The bearing of this half mile, is therefore, N. $89^{\circ}50'$ W., and the distance 39.84 chs.

RETRACEMENT OF PORTION OF W. BDY. T. 29 N., R. 21 E.

From the closing cor. of secs. 19 and 24, on W. bdy. of township, which is an iron post, 3 ins. diam., firmly set in the ground, mkd. and witnessed as described in the official record.

North, on retracement along west boundary of T. 29 N., R. 21 E.

256.65 Fall 90 lks. W. of the cor. of Tps. 29 and 30 E., Rs. 20 and 21 E., which is a 3 in. iron post, firmly set in the ground, mkd. and witnessed as described in the official record.

The bearing of this fractional boundary, is therefore, N.  $0^{\circ}12'$  E., and the distance 256.65 chs.

COMPLETING SUBDIVISION OF T. 29 N., R. 21 E.

Method of Procedure.

Owing to the E. bdy. connecting the closing cor. of frac. secs. 19 and 24 on the Pyramid Lake Indian Reservation boundary, with the cor. of Tps. 29 and 30 N., Rs. 21 and 22 E., giving a true course of N.  $0^{\circ}08'$  E., the following meridional subdivision lines were run parallel thereto, initiating from the closing cors. on the reservation boundary, however, counting the distances from the section cors. on the second latitudinal subdivision line.

I commence the subdivisional survey at the closing cor. of secs. 23 and 24, on the Pyramid Lake Indian Reservation boundary, which is an iron post, 1 in. diam., firmly set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the official record. This cor. is N.  $0^{\circ}01'$  W., 30.27 chs. from the cor. of secs. 23, 24, 25, and 26, as described in the official record.
