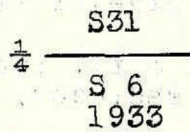


SURVEY OF THE S. BDY. T. 19 S., R. 63 E.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.



raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, N. of cor.

Land, rolling.

Small gully, course SE.; asc. 22 ft.

29.70

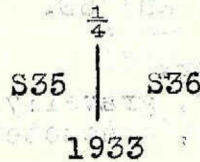
Top of ascent; desc. 3 ft.
