20.40 Old road, bears N. and S. about 6 chs. then SW.

39.50 Wash, course S.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, in a mound of stone, for the closing cor. of secs. 7 and 18, with brass cap mkd.
