

SUBDIVISION OF T. 18 S., R. 63 E.

Chains

47.50 Base of rocky hills, bears N. and S.

67.00 Broad, shallow dry wash, 100 ft. below 1/4 sec. cor., 1 ch. wide, drains NE.; asc. gentle E, slope over flood plain to very dense undergrowth.

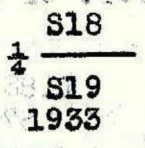
80.00 The cor. of secs. 17, 18, 19 and 20. Land, E. 1/2 mile, mountainous and broken hilly; W. 1/2 mile, rollings and hilly. Soil, shallow, rocky on steep slopes; sandy and gravelly on balance of mile; 3rd and 4th rate. Undergrowth, creosote and cacti. No timber.

West, on true line, bet. secs. 18 and 19. Asc. gradually on gentle E. slope, through dense undergrowth.

5.50 A dry wash, 70 lks. wide, 6 to 8 ft. deep, drains N. 80° E.

29.90 Lowest point in broad shallow dry wash, approximately 1 ch. wide, drains N. 70° E.

40.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 12 ins. in the ground to solid rock, with a limestone 10x8x2 ins., marked with cross (X), deposited at base and in a large mound of stone, for the 1/4 sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.



This corner is situated on a gravelly S. slope, about 2 chs. N. of wash.

45.50 Recross broad wash, drains S. 75° E. from N. 85° W.

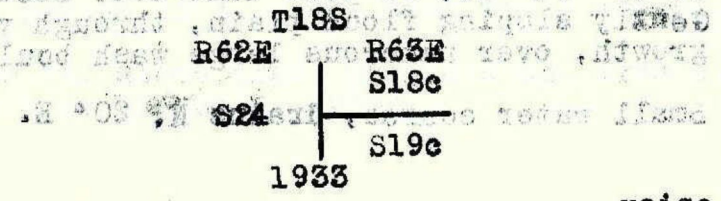
52.50 Junction of dry washes, from N. 60° W. and S. 80° W., bears N., 50 lks. dist.; wash, drains S. 85° E.

54.50 Small dry wash, drains N. 80° E.

60.90 Small dry wash, drains N. 60° E.

69.74 Intersect W. bdy. of Tp. S. 4.10 chs. dist. from the cor. of secs. 13 and 24, which is an iron post 3 ins. diam., marked and witnessed, as heretofore described.

At point of intersection, Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for the closing cor. of secs. 18 and 19, with brass cap mkd.



raise a mound of stone 5 ft. base, 3 ft. high, E. of cor.
