

SUBDIVISION OF T. 18 S., R. 63 E.

Chains

Establishment of the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. for sec. 5, on the N. bdy. of T. 18 S., R. 63 E.

At midpoint between the closing cor. of secs. 4 and 5, and the closing cor. of secs. 5 and 6, on the N. bdy. of T. 18 S., R. 63 E., heretofore described.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

raise a mound of stone, 5 ft. base, 3 ft. high, S. of cor.

From this cor. the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 32, T. 17 S., R. 63 E. heretofore described, bears S. 89°23' E., 657 chs. dist. *lks.*

Establishment of the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor for sec. 6, on the N. bdy. of T. 18 S., R. 63 E.

At a point 40.00 chs. westing from the closing cor. of secs. 5 and 6, heretofore described,

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 ins. diam., 25 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

$\frac{1}{4}$ S6

raise a mound of stone, 4 ft. base, 3 ft. high, S. of cor.

From this cor. the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 31, T. 17 S., R. 63 E., heretofore described bears S. 89°23' E., 800 lks. dist.

Establishment of the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. for sec. 31, on the W. bdy. of T. 18 S., R. 63 E.

True point for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. which is midway between the closing cor. of Tps. 18 and 19 S., R. 63 E., described in book "A" this group and the closing cor. of secs. 30 and 31, heretofore described, falls on a cliff where it is impracticable to set a permanent monument.

The witness $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. for sec. 36, T. 18 S., R. 62 E. heretofore described was therefore marked to refer also to Sec. 31, T. 18 S., R. 63 E.

The witness cor. bears N. 9.60 chs. dist. from the true point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 31.
