Land, rolling bench land with general E. exposure and drainage.

Soil, sandy and gravelly with some loose rock scattered on surface; 2nd. to 4th. rates.

No timber.

Undergrowth, scattered to medium growth of creosote and chaparral.

N.0°59'W., bet. secs. 1 and 6.

Over rolling and broken ground through medium growth of undergrowth.

25.30 Enter large wash draining E.

31.30 Leave wash, bears E. and W.

38.65 Northing of 40.00 chs. from the cor. of secs. 6 and 7, T.22 S., R.65 E.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 28 ins.
