

Dependent Resurvey of the East Boundary of T. 3 N., R. 57 E.

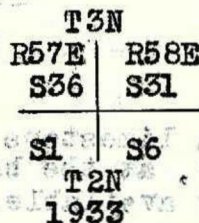
Chains

TRUE LINES.

Beginning at the corner of Tps. 2 and 3 N., Rs. 57 and 58 E., which is marked by a basalt stone 4x4x2 ins. lying on a small mound of earth and stone, and marked dimly with 6 notches on two opposite faces.

At the corner point,

Set an iron post, 3 feet long, 3 inches in diameter, 30 ins. in the ground for the corner of Tps. 2 and 3 N., Rs. 57 and 58 E., with brass cap marked:



Deposit the original corner stone alongside the post.

Thence

N. 1°24' W., along the W. boundary of section 31, T. 3 N., R. 58 E.

Over nearly level land; with a gentle SE. slope, through dense undergrowth.

22.00 Small wash, drains SE.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diameter, 30 ins. in the ground, for the 1/4 section corner of section 36 T. 3 N., R. 57 E., with brass cap marked:

Deposit a limestone rock, 5x4x2 ins. marked with a cross (X) at the base of the post. No other suitable accessory available.

40.69 Intersect the original 1/4 section corner, a basalt stone, 7x5x3 ins. marked 1/4 on the top face, lying on a mound of earth.

At the corner point,

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long and one in. in diameter, 25 ins. in the ground, and in a mound of stone; for the 1/4 section corner of section 31 T. 3 N., R. 58 E., with brass cap marked:



1933

Deposit the original corner stone at the base of the post.

Thence

N. 0°09' E.; with continuous measurement.
