Chains Soil: Shallow gravelly to rocky loam; 3rd rate.
 Timber: Pinon, juniper and mahogany.
 Undergrowth: Sagebrush and service berry brush. Bunch
 grass.
 Fair grazing.

North, along the east boundary of section 1, T. 3 N., R.
 56 E.

Over mountainous country, through medium dense timber and
 a scant undergrowth.

Descend 140 feet over a N. slope.

10.20 Draw, drains E.; ascend 245 ft. along a rocky SE. slope.

23.00 Spur, projects E.; descend 460 ft. along a NE. slope.

40.00 On a steep NE. slope,

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long and 1 in. in diameter, 29
 ins. in the ground, for the $\frac{1}{4}$ section corner of section
 1, T. 3 N., R. 56 E., with brass cap marked:

A pinon, 5 ins. in diameter, marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S1BT, bears
 N. 16°45' W., 190 links distant.

Descend 25 ft. over a N. slope.

42.90 Cherry Creek; stream of clear water, 5 ft. wide and 6
 ins. deep, flows SE.

45.12 Old road, bears NW. and SE.; ascend 420 ft. along a SE.
 slope.

57.00 Spur, projects SE.; continue ascent along a SE. slope.

86.01 Intersect the N. boundary of T. 3 N., R. 57 E., projected
 W. from the corner of Tps. 3 and 4, N., Rs. 57 and 58 E.,
 heretofore described.

At the point of intersection, on top of a spur projecting SW.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long and 3 ins. in diameter, 30
 ins. in the ground, for the corner of Tps. 3 and 4, N.,
 Rs. 56 and 57 E., with brass cap marked:
