

Subdivision of T. 3 N., R. 57 E.

Chains

whence

A pinon, 6 ins. in diameter, marked $\frac{1}{2}$ S18BT, bears N. 55°15' E., 51 links distant.

A pinon, 4 ins. in diameter, marked $\frac{1}{2}$ S18BT, bears S. 70°00' E., 17 links distant.

At a point 1.53 chains N. of the $\frac{1}{4}$ section corner of section 12, T. 3 N., R. 56 E., heretofore described, and midway between the closing corners of sections 6 and 7, and of sections 7 and 18, both heretofore described,

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long and 1 in. in diameter, 24 ins. in the ground to solid rock, and in a mound of stone, for the $\frac{1}{4}$ section corner of section 7, T. 3 N., R. 57 E., with brass cap marked:

A pinon, 3 ins. in diameter, marked BT, bears N. 70°00' E., 14 links distant.

No other suitable tree available for marking.

At a point 1.54 chains N. of the $\frac{1}{4}$ section corner of section 1, T. 3 N., R. 56 E., heretofore described, and 40 chains N. of the closing corner of sections 6 and 7, T. 3 N., R. 57 E., heretofore described,

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long and 1 in. in diameter, 27 ins. in the ground, and in a mound of stone, for the $\frac{1}{4}$ section corner of section 6, T. 3 N., R. 57 E., with brass cap marked:
