42.82	Angle point 3/55, T. 13 S., R. 71 E., which is an iron post, mkd. and witnessed as described in Book "D", of this group.
	Continue North, bet. Tracts 37 and 55.
62.82	Accepted property cor., now mkd. by an iron post, mkd. and witnessed, as described in Book "D", of this group.
83.06	Angle point 2/55 and 3/52, both in T. 13 S., R. 71 E., which is an iron post, mkd. and witnessed, as described in Book "D", of this group.
	Continue North, bet. Tracts 37 and 52.
93.56	Witness angle point 1/37, T. 13 S., R. 70 E. and 2/52, T. 13 S., R. 71 E., which is an iron post, mkd. and witnessed as described in Book "D", of this group.
99.32	Angle point, 1/37, the place of beginning.
	The NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of original sec. 26, State Selection List No. 21, approved June 3, 1893, which becomes Tract 38 under this resurvey is entirely within the boundaries of Tract 37. The record of the completion of Tract 38 ³⁷ , segregating this area, may be found in the combined record of the survey of Tract 37 ³⁸ .
	TRACT 38
	State Selection, List No. 21, approved June 3, 1893, embracing the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of sec. 26, 40 acres.
	The initial point of control for the location of this entry is taken from a point agreed upon by local property holders as the original $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 25 and 26, and which is mkd. by an old drill stem. This point is taken as the NE. cor. of the claim. The N. bdy. is established bet. this point and a point determined by the projection of fence lines to the N., S., and W. to a common intersection as the NW. cor. of the claim. The E. bdy. is established bet. the original NE. cor. of the claim and a point in an old pomegranate hedge, identified by landholders in the locality as the SE. cor. of the claim. The S. bdy. is run to an accepted point for the SW. cor. of the claim and the W. bdy. is established in harmony therewith. The position of the boundaries as thus determined is fully acceptable to adjoining landholders in this locality.
	Beginning at the NE. cor. of the claim, which is mkd. by an old drill stem, firmly embedded in the ground.
	Along side of drill stem.
	Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., flush with the ground in concrete for angle point 1/38, identical with 7/37, with brass cap mkd.
