General Description

The area covered by this survey lies on the western slopes and drainages of Table Mountain in the Spring Mountain Range. All of section 7 and the south half of section 6 lie in a gently sloping pocket surrounded by hills 1000 to 1500 ft. high and drains westward through the medium of Bonanza Wash. The north half of section 6 lies on steep mountain slopes facing south and west.

Elevations over the area vary from about 3200 ft. to 4300 ft. The area is devoid of timber and undergrowth is low and scattering.

There are numerous mineral claims, many of which are patented, within the area and surrounding it and some mining work is still carried on in the area. The locally well known Singer Mine is situated in the NW_4^2 of section 18.
