- 44.00 Draw, drains N. 80° E.; asc. 80 ft. over a SW. slope.
- 52.80 Knoll; desc. 50 ft. abruptly.
- 57.70 Wash, 15 lks. wide, course SE.; asc. 300 ft. along a rocky E. slope.
- 67.30 Shallow draw, drains S. 10° W.
- 80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam., over a cross X, on granite ledge, and in a mound of stone 3 1/2 ft. base, to top, for the cor. of Tps. 32 and 33 N., Rs. 68 and 69 E., with brass cap mkd.

SOUTH BOUNDARY OF T. 32 N., R. 68 E.
