RESURVEY OF EAST BOUNDARY OF T. 32 N., R. 67 E.

Dependent resurvey of the E. bdy. T. 32 N., R. 67 E., reestablishing the survey executed by Snyles and Freble, U. S. Deputy Surveyors, in 1881.

Extensive retracements prior to the date of this Dependent Resurvey reveal the total obliteration of evidence of the original survey. As described in the following field notes, the cor. of Ts. 32 and 33 N., R. 67 E., was restored at proportionate distance between the stan. cor. of Ts. 31 N., Rs. 67 and 68 E., and the cor. of secs. 13 and 24, on the east bdy. of T. 34 N., R. 67 E., and at record distance, east of the cor. of secs. 2, 3, 34 and 35 on the N. bdy. of T. 32 N., R. 66 E., these being the nearest original or restored corners to the N. S. and W.

From the cor. of Ts. 31 and 32 N., R. 67 E., an iron post, 3 ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of the resurvey of the E. bdy. of T. 31 N., R. 67 E., executed under group 194, Nev.
