A pinon, 7 ins. diam., bears N. 28° E., 245 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S31 BT.


A pinon, 8 ins. diam., bears S. 24 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E., 70 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S6 BT.

48.40 Leave timber, bears S. 80° W. and N. 80° E.; desc. 200 ft. over rolling general W. slope.

72.13 N., 32 lks. from the tangent,

Intersect E. bdy. of T. 32 N., R. 67 E.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for closing cor. of Ts. 32 and 33 N., R. 68 E., with brass cap mkd.



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of stone, 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base, 3 ft. high, E. of cor. raise a mound

From point of intersection, the cor. of Ts. 32 and 33 N., R. 67 E., bears N. 0° 38' E., 21.61 chs. dist.

From the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36, on the S. bdy. of the tp., N. 0° 01' W., bet. secs. 35 and 36.

Desc. 20 ft. over N. slope.


0.50 Over level canyon floor.

3.00 Watercourse in canyon, course SE.

4.00 Leave bottom of canyon; asc. 700 ft. over rocky SW. slope.

30.00 Crest of ridge, bears SE. and N. 20° W.; desc. 90 ft. along E. slope.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 20 ins. in the ground, to bedrock and in a mound of stone to top, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.
