 14.00 Slopes change to NE.
 19.10 Base of NE. slope; enter bottom, brs. N.60°W., and S.60°E.
 20.25 Old Belmont and Tybo road, brs. N.60°W., and S.60°E.
 21.16 Power transmission line, brs. NW. and SE.
 21.30 Wash in bottom of draw, 4 lks. wide, 3 ft. deep, drains
 S. 70° E.
 22.30 Leave bottom, bears NW. and SE
 Asc. broken SW. to S. slope 270 ft. to $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
 26.70 Enter small draw, drains SW. from N.

 36.00 Leave draw, drains S. from N. 15° E. Asc. S. slope

 62.00 Small draw, drains S. 60° E., heads about 8 chs. N.30° W.
 Asc. S. slope 170 ft. to
 71.40 Small spur, projects SE.
 Desc. abrupt N. slope 30 ft. to
 72.00 Small rough draw, drains S. 60° E., heads about 2 chs. W.
