

SURVEY OF PORTION OF W. BOUNDARY T. 8 N., R. 46 E.

Chains	From the cor. of T. 8 N., Rs. 45 and 46 E. North, bet. secs. 31 and 36. Over rolling land through dense undergrowth, Desc. gentle N. slope of bottom land
1.21	3 strand wire fence, barbed, bears N. 80° E. and S. 80° W. to cor. of secs. 5 and 6, thence W.
2.00	Enter field Dry wash, 10, lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, drains W.
3.90	Leave undergrowth and enter cultivated meadow, bears E. and W.
9.35	Leave cultivated field, bears N. 60° E. and S. 60° W. Enter high sagebrush
9.46	3 strand barbed wire fence, bears S. 61-3/4° W. and N. 61-3/4° E about 5 chs., thence S.
9.60	Road, bears N. 61° E. to Belmont and head of Hunt's Canyon and S. 61° W. to Manhattan
10.00	Leave bottom, bears N. 60° E. and S. 60° W. Asc. rocky broken S. slope 430 ft. to 37.00
19.00	Small rocky draw, drains S. 60° E. 5 chs. to large draw, thence S.
37.00	Small rocky spur, projects E. Thence along rocky E. slope
40.00	Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. dia., 17 ins. in the ground to solid rock, in a large mound of stone, over a chiseled(X)cross, for the 1/4 sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.
	From which A mound of stone on conical butte, bears N. 79° 32' E., about 1 1/4 miles dist.
50.00	Head of small draw, drains SE. Asc. rocky S. slope 230 ft. to
59.40	Spur ridge, projects S. 60° W. from N. 60° E. Desc. along broken W. slope
63.20	Small draw, drains W., heads about 3 chs. E.
