<p>Chains</p> <p>54.70</p> <p>57.94</p> <p>72.10</p> <p>79.17</p> <p>80.00</p> <p>1.90</p> <p>9.70</p> <p>17.95</p>	<p>In a small swale draining SW:</p> <p>Set an iron post, 3 ft. long and 1 in. in diameter, 26 ins. in the ground for the $\frac{1}{2}$ section corner, with brass cap marked:</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>$\frac{1}{2}$S32</u> 1931</p> <p>Raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base and $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high north of the post.</p> <p>Continue over gently rolling bench land.</p> <p>Wash, 10 links wide and 3 ft. deep, drains SW.</p> <p>3 Strand barbed wire fence, bears N and S 1.20 chains to corner, thence W.</p> <p>Wash, 3 ft. deep and 10 lks. wide, drains SW.</p> <p>Road, Tonopah to Willow Creek Ranch, bears S and N.</p> <p>North 20 links from the tangent.</p> <p>On a gentle E slope:</p> <p>Set an iron post, 3 ft. long and 2 ins. in diameter, 27 ins. in the ground, for the corner of sections 31 and 32, with brass cap marked:</p> <p style="text-align: center;">T 8NR48E <u>S31 S32</u> 1931</p> <p>Raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base and $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high north of the post. Deposit a purple basalt stone, 8"x4"x3", marked with a cross (X) at the base of the post.</p> <p>Land, rolling bench, S exposure, SW drainage.</p> <p>Soil, sandy to gravelly clay, 4th rate.</p> <p>Timber, None.</p> <p>Undergrowth, sagebrush, black sagebrush. Bunch grass.</p> <p>Fair grazing.</p> <hr/> <p>West, along the south boundary of section 31, on a transit line describing the tangent and which bears S 89°56' W.</p> <p>Over gently rolling land, through medium growth of sagebrush and a scant growth of grass, ascend 20 ft. over an E slope.</p> <p>Low spur, projects S, descend 35 ft. along a SW slope.</p> <p>Wash, 10 lks. wide and 3 ft. deep, drains S 10° E, ascend 35 ft. along an E slope to spur.</p> <p>3 Strand barbed wire fence, bears N and S 1.08 chains to corner, thence east.</p>
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
