Raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, E. of cor.

Land: Gently rolling; drainage SE.

Soil: Deep sandy to gravelly loam, 2nd rate.

Timber: None.

Undergrowth: Sagebrush. Bunch grass.

Good grazing.

North Boundary


Beginning at the corner of Ts 8 and 9 N, Rs. 47 $\frac{1}{2}$ and 48 E, an iron post, 3 ins. in diameter, firmly set, properly marked and witnessed as described in the field notes of T 8 N, R 48 E, surveyed under this group.

Thence

West, between sections 1 and 36.

Over mountainous land, through medium dense pinon and juniper timber and a scant undergrowth of sagebrush; descend 20 ft. along a SW slope.

- 1.80 Draw, drains SE; ascend 75 ft. along a NE slope.
- 14.50 Ridge, bears NW and SE; descend 25 ft. along a SW slope.
- 27.90 Draw, drains S 30° E; ascend 80 ft. along a NE slope.
- 40.00 On the top of a ridge bearing N 30° W and S 30° E:
Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone, for $\frac{1}{4}$ section corner, with brass cap marked:

from which

- A pinon, 8 ins. diam., bears S 54° 30' W, 91 links dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S1BT.
- A pinon, 7 ins. diam., bears N 48° 15' W, 105 links dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S36BT.

Descend 35 ft. along a SW slope.

- 43.90 Draw, drains SE; ascend 255 ft. along a SE slope.
- 58.60 Spur, projects SW; descend 45 ft. along a W slope;
- 66.00 Draw, drains SW; ascend 90 ft. along a SE slope.
- 68.45 Spur, projects SW; descend 55 ft. along a NW slope.
