

## RETRACEMENT OF A PORTION OF T. 16 N., R. 21 E., M D Mer., Nevada.

## Chains

At the point for the cor. of secs. 19, 24, 25 and 30 on the W. bdy. of the Twp., which is mkd. by a scribed fragment of the original cor. post in the center of an embedded mound of stones. The position is further verified by record distance to the stumps of two original bearing trees.

At point for cor.,

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, and mounded to top of post, for cor. of secs. 19, 24, 25 and 30, with brass cap mkd.

Remains of the original bearing trees; scribe marks not visible.

A juniper stump, 12 ins. diam., bears N.31 $\frac{1}{2}$ °E., 375 lks. dist.

A juniper stump, 8 ins. diam., bears S.49 3/4° W., 169 lks. dist.

And new bearing trees,

A juniper limb, 4 ins. diam., from the original stump, bears N.32°E., 376 lks. dist., mkd BT

A juniper, 8 ins. diam., bears S.23 $\frac{1}{2}$ °E., 242 lks. dist., mkd T16N R21E S30 BT

A juniper, 6 ins. diam., bears S.45 $\frac{1}{4}$ °W., 175 lks. dist., mkd T16N R20E S25 BT

A juniper, 8 ins. diam., bears N.35 $\frac{1}{4}$ °W., 405 lks. dist., mkd. T16N R20E S24 BT

N.88°23'E., bet. secs. 19 and 30. ( West half mile.)

The point for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 19 and 30 which is mkd. by an old mound of stones partially covered with loose earth and with large sagebrush growing between stones at the edges,

At point for cor.,

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 12 ins. in the ground to underlying rock, with a basalt rock 6x5x4 ins., mkd. X, deposited at the base, and in a large mound of stone to the top, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.
