

EAST BOUNDARY OF T. 22 N., R. 54 E.

Chains

A mahogany, 7 ins. diam., bears S.25°W., 156 lks. dist., mkd. BT only. Desc: 270 ft. over rocky N. slope.

49.40 Draw, drains N.80°W. from SE., asc. 170 ft. over S. slope.


60.90 Spur, slopes W., desc. 90 ft. over abrupt N. slope.

68.00 Draw, drains W., continue across bottom of draw.

70.30 Dry creek channel, 20 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, course SW. to draw. Asc. 200 ft. over rocky SE. slope.

80.10 A point which is East of the reestablished cor. of secs. 34 and 35, on the S. bdy. of T. 23 N., R. 54 E., hereinbefore described.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam., 32 ins. in the ground, for cor. of Tps. 22 and 23 N., Rs. 54 and 55 E., with brass cap mkd.



of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, S. of cor. raise a mound

Land, mountainous. Soil, shallow rocky loam, 3rd and 4th rate. Timber, pinon pine, mahogany, aspen, juniper. Undergrowth, chokecherry, serviceberry, deer brush, sagebrush, buck brush, willows. Grazing, excellent.

SURVEY OF THE SUBDIVISION OF T. 22 N., R. 54 E.

I commence the subdivisional survey at the cor. of secs. 35, 36, 36 and 35 on the S. bdy. of the Tp.,

N. 0°01' W., bet. secs. 35 and 36,


Asc. 50 ft. over SW. slope through heavy timber and scattering undergrowth.

2.80 Rocky spur, slopes N.80°W., desc. 180 ft. over abrupt N. slope.

7.00 Draw, drains N.60°W., asc. 270 ft. over SW. slope.

20.80 Spur, slopes W., desc. 690 ft. over NW. slope to draw.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 6 ins. in the ground to bedrock, over a cross (X) and in a large mound of stone, 4 ft. base, for 1/4 sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

A pinon pine, 6 ins. diam., bears N.42 3/4°E., 18 lks. dist., mkd. BT only
