67.50 Old unimproved highway from Las Vegas, Nevada to the Colorado River, bears E. and W.

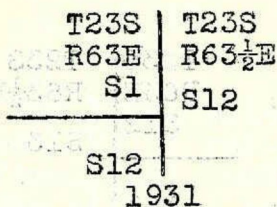
69.70 New State highway (under construction), bears N.86°04' W. to Las Vegas and S.86°04'E. to Boulder City, Nev.; survey station #B990, bears N.86°04'W. 8 lks. distant.

71.99 Western Union Telegraph line, bears N.85°33'W. and S.85°33'E.

72.64 Boulder City branch of the Union Pacific Ry., bears N.85°33'W. and S.85°33'E. ; station #1055, bears S.85°33'E., 58 lks. distant.

80.75 Proportionate point.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in dia., 28 ins. in the ground for cor. of secs. 1 and 12, T.23 S., R.63 E., with brass cap marked



raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 3 ft. high, W. of cor.

Cor. stands at S. base of low rolling hills bearing NE. and W., 250 ft. above the cor. of secs. 12 and 13.

Land, gently rolling; general S. exposure and drainage. Soil, coarse gravelly loam and stony; 3rd. and 4th. rates.

No timber.

Undergrowth, creosote, sagebrush, and cacti.

N.0°12'E., along E. bdy. sec. 1, T.23 S., R.63 E.

Ascend over rolling and broken hills through creosote and sagebrush undergrowth.

20.50 Begin ascent over broken SW. slope of rocky hills, bears NW. and E.

30.20 Small spur, 180 ft. above sec. cor., projects SW.; continue over broken SW. slope.

40.375 Proportionate point.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 28 ins. in the ground for ¼ sec. cor. E. bdy. sec. 1, T.23 S., R.63 E., with brass cap marked
