

INDEPENDENT RESURVEY EAST BOUNDARY OF T.23 S., R.64 E.

Chains

From this point Mile Cor. No.3 of the reservation boundary bears East, 2.05 chs. distant; and iron post, 3 ins. in dia., firmly set, and marked and witnessed as described in the official record.

Land, gently rolling; drains SW.

Soil, coarse sandy and gravelly loams and rocky; 3rd. and 4th. rates.

No timber.


Undergrowth, creosote and desert sagebrush.

South, bet. secs. 25 and 30.

Over gently rolling land through creosote undergrowth.


3.60 Wash, 30 lks. wide, drains S.70°W.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 6 ins. in the ground on solid rock and supported by a large mound of stone for 1/4 sec. cor., with brass cap marked



1931 deposit a basalt rock, 8x8x6 ins., marked with a cross (+) on one face at base of post.

80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in dia., 20 ins. in the ground on solid rock and supported by a mound of stone for cor. of secs. 25,30,31, and 36, with brass cap marked



1931 raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 3 ft. high, W. of cor.

Land, gently rolling; drains SW.

Soil, coarse sandy and gravelly loams and rocky; 4th. rate.

No timber.

Undergrowth, creosote.

South, bet. secs. 31 and 36.

Gradually ascend over rolling land through creosote and sagebrush undergrowth.
