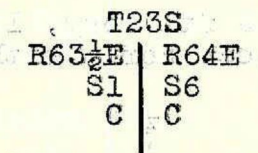
Chains

North, bet. secs. 1 and 6.  
Ascend over rolling and broken mountainous land through creosote and chaparral undergrowth.

6.00 Spur, 50 ft. above sec. cor., projects S.10°W.; continue ascent over W. and SW. slopes.

19.96 Intersect Boulder Canyon Project, Federal Reservation Boundary.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in dia., 28 ins. in the ground for closing cor. of secs. 1 and 6, with brass cap marked

raise a mound of stone, 4 ft. base, 3 ft. high, N. of cor.

From this cor., the 16th. Mile Cor. of the reservation boundary, bears West, 18.02 chs. distant; an iron post, 3 ins. in dia., firmly set, and marked and witnessed as described in the official record.

40.00 On SW. slope near top of spur projecting SE., 210 ft. above sec. cor.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 28 ins. in the ground for ¼ sec. cor., with brass cap marked

41.25 Spur, projects SE.; gradually descend.

44.67 Draw, drains SE.; gradually ascend.

49.10 Begin ascent over abrupt S. slope.

57.35 Junction of spurs projecting SW. and SE. from N.10°W., 300 ft. above draw; descend 70 ft. to

62.75 Head of draw, drains E.; ascend 310 ft. over broken SE. slope over numerous outcrops and ledges.

79.10 Rocky ridge, bears W., E. about 2 chs., then NE. and SE.; descend.

80.00 On NW. slope 20 ft. below ridge.
