

INDEPENDENT RESURVEY OF SUBDIVISION, T. 21 S., R. 65 E.

Chains

79.99 The cor. of secs. 2, 3, 10, and 11, 50 ft. below ridge.

Land, broken and mountainous, with a general southerly exposure and drainage.

Soil, gravelly, sandy, and rocky, with clay; conglomerate formation; 3rd rate.

Undergrowth, creosote, shadscale, and greasewood.

No timber.

N. 0°03' E., bet. secs. 2 and 3.

Ascend gradually along rocky E. slope of broken mountainous land, through scattered short undergrowth.

2.00 Ridge, 10 ft. above cor., bears SW. and NE.; descend gradual NW. slope.

8.00 Base of descent, 50 ft. below ridge, bears NE. and SW.; ascend gradually across bottom of wide draw.

16.00 Center of wash, 5.00 chs. wide, 4 ft. deep, in draw, drains SW.; continue across bottom of draw.

22.00 The N. edge of draw, bears NE. and SW.; ascend rocky SE. slope.

31.00 Top of black spur, 185 ft. above base of descent, projects SW.; descend rocky NW. slope.

35.27 Intersect the fifth standard parallel south, R. 65 E., East, 28.37 chs. dist. from the standard cor. of secs. 34 and 35, which is an iron post, 2 ins. diam., firmly set, marked and witnessed as described in the official records, book "A" of this group.

At point of intersection; at base of descent, 100 ft. below spur, bears S. 80° W. and N. 80° E.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 18 ins. in the ground to bedrock and in a mound of stone to top, for closing cor. of secs. 2 and 3, with brass cap marked

deposit a volcanic stone, 8 x 5 x 4 ins., at base of post, marked with a cross (X).
