Chains

MEANDERS OF THE RIGHT BANK COLORADO RIVER, DOWN STREAM.

From the meander cor. of secs. 19 and 24, T. 21 S., Rs. 65 and 66 E., which is an iron post, 1 in. diam., firmly set, marked and witnessed as described in book "B" of this group:

Thence with meanders of the right bank of the Colorado River in sec. 24.

Along rocky bank void of vegetation.

S. 37°30' W., 2.50 chs.

S. 42°00' W., 15.80 chs. This course follows along high vertical cliffs.

S. 86°45' W., 4.90 chs.

S. 89°15' W., 7.40 chs. At the end of this course, leave cliffs and enter dense willows and scattered willow trees, on cut bank from 4 to 8 ft. high

N. 86°00' W., 4.52 chs.

S. 88°30' W., 2.60 chs.

N. 82°00' W., 2.90 chs.

N. 89°15' W., 6.40 chs.

S. 69°30' W., 8.30 chs. At the end of this course, leave willow trees. thence along low sandy bank.

S. 86°30' W., 6.70 chs.

S. 58°45' W., 10.90 chs. At 5.40 chs. on this course, wash, 80 lks. wide, 10 ft. deep from the N.

S. 18°30' W., 10.30 chs.

S. 32°45' W., 7.60 chs.

S. 48°15' W., 11.20 chs. At 3.20 chs. on this course, Callville Wash, 4.00 chs. wide, from the NW. At the end of this course, intersect the true point for the meander cor. of secs. 23 and 24, which is S. 0°03' W., 50 lks. dist. from the witness cor. to the meander cor. of said secs. heretofore described.

Land broken on E. portion, nearly level on W. portion.

Soil, rocky on E. portion, sand and clay on W. portion; 2nd and 4th rates.

Undergrowth, willows, and mesquite.

Timber, a few scattered willow trees.

Thence in sec. 23, from the true point for meander cor. of secs. 23 and 24.

Along gravelly and sandy sloping bank, through scattered willows.
