80.18	The cor. of secs. 2, 3, 10, and 11, 80 ft. above wash. Land, rolling and mountainous, with a general northwesterly exposure and drainage. Soil, gravelly and rocky; 3rd rate. Undergrowth, creosote and cacti. No timber.
	N. 0°10' E., bet. secs. 2 and 3, on true line.
	Over rocky mountainous land, through scattered undergrowth.
3.90	Draw, drains S. 10° W.
8.40	Spur, projects S. 30° W.; ascend rocky SW. slope.
10.30	Draw, drains S. 30° W.
13.90	Rocky spur, 115 ft. above cor., projects N. 30° W.; descend rocky N. slope.
20.25	Wash, drains N. 20° W.
24.45	Rocky spur, projects N. 20° W.
40.00	Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 10 ins. in the ground to bedrock and in a mound of stone to top, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap marked
