Chains

- 42.00 Wash, drains W.
- 55.50 Wash, drains W.
- 65.85 Low spur, projects W.
- 70.00 Head of shallow draw, drains W.
- 79.25 Low spur, projects N. 20° W.
- 83.58 Intersect the S. bdy. sec. 33, T. 21 S., R. 63 E., S. 88°07' W., 8.01 chs. dist. from the cor. of secs. 33 and 34, which is an iron post, 2 ins. diam., firmly set, marked and witnessed as described in the official records, book "B" of this group.

At point of intersection.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 14 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone to top, for closing cor. of secs. 3 and 4, T. 22 S., R. 63 E., with brass cap marked

trachyte, 6 x 5 x 5 ins., at base of post, marked with a cross (X).

Land, rolling and mountainous, with a general westerly exposure and drainage.

Soil, gravelly and rocky; 3rd rate.

Undergrowth, chaparral.

No timber.

From the cor. of secs. 4, 5, 32, and 33, on the S. bdy. of the township, which is an iron post, 2 ins. diam., firmly set, marked and witnessed as described in the official records, book "B" of this group.

N. 0°08' E., bet. secs. 32 and 33.

Descend gradual NW. slope of rolling land, through medium dense undergrowth.

- 10.30 Low spur, projects NE.
- 19.30 Main wash, drains NE.
- 40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 30 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap marked
