


INDEPENDENT RESURVEY OF SUBDIVISION, T. 22 S., R. 63 E.

Chains

At point of intersection;

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for closing cor. of secs. 6 and 7, T. 22 S., R. 63 E., with brass cap marked

raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, E. of cor.

Land, rolling, with a general northwesterly exposure and drainage.

Soil, gravelly and rock; 3rd rate.

Undergrowth, creosote and chaparral.

No timber.

From the cor. of secs. 5, 6, 7, and 8.

N. 0°08' E., bet. secs. 5 and 6, on true line.


Over flood plain draining northwesterly, through medium dense undergrowth.

17.00 Main draw, drains NW.

21.20 Telephone line, bears N. 56°05' W. and S. 56°05' E.

21.60 Road, bears N. 56° W. to Las Vegas and S. 56° E. to the Colorado River.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap marked



raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, W. of cor.

Cor. is 50 ft. below the cor. of secs. 5, 6, 7, and 8.

81.95 Intersect the S. bdy. of sec. 31, T. 21 S., R. 63 E., S. 89°42' W., 4.97 chs. dist. from the cor. of secs. 31 and 32, which is an iron post, 2 ins. diam., firmly set, marked and witnessed as described in the official records, book "B" of this group.

At point of intersection:
