GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The lands in this fractional township are rough and broken mountainous with a general west drainage. There

are no prominent topographic features.

No settlers reside in the towship. An old road and the recently constructed telephone line; Las Vegas to Boulder City, run northwesterly thru a portion of sec.
