	<p>From this cor., the ¼ sec. cor. bet. secs. 31 and 36, T.22 S., Rs. 63½ and 64 E., bears West, 1.98 chs. distant; for description of cor. see Book "B", this group.</p>
	<p>Continue descent.</p>
51.70	<p>Spur, projects N.5° E.</p>
60.65	<p>Draw, 140 ft. below the 17½ Mile Cor., drains NW.; ascend SW. slope.</p>
66.75	<p>Spur, 30 ft. above draw, projects NW.; descend.</p>
69.65	<p>Draw, 45 ft. below spur, drains SW. about 3 chs., then NW.</p>
77.10	<p>Recross same draw, drains NE.</p>
80.00	<p>Intersect line bet. secs. 30 and 31, T.22 S., Rs. 64 E.</p>
	<p>Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. in dia., 6 ins. in the ground on solid rock and supported by a large mound of stone for the 18th. Mile Cor. and the closing cor. of secs. 30 and 31, T.22 S., R.64 E., with brass cap marked T22SR64E</p>

	<p>From this cor., the cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36, T.22 S., Rs. 63½ and 64 E., bears West, 1.98 chs. distant; for description of cor. see Book "B", this group.</p>
	<p>Land, rough mountainous; general M. exposure.</p>
	<p>Soil, clay, sandy and gravelly loams and rocky of volcanic formation; 4th rate.</p>
	<p>No timber.</p>
	<p>Undergrowth, scattering creosote, shadscale and chaparral.</p>
	<p>North, on the 19th Mile.</p>
	<p>Gradually descend NE slope over mountainous land through creosote, shadscale and chaparral undergrowth.</p>
9.20	<p>Draw, 75 ft. below mile cor., drains N.60°W. from S.10°E.; ascend.</p>
11.65	<p>Spur, 15 ft. above draw, projects NW.; gradually descend over N. slope.</p>
13.26	<p>Telephone line, bears N.70°W. and S.70°E.</p>
16.15	<p>Draw from the SE., 30 ft. below spur, drains N.70°W.; gradually ascend.</p>
