Chains

Land, rough mountains; general N. exposure.

Soil, clay and gravelly loams and rocky of limestone and volcanic formations; 3rd. and 4th. rates.

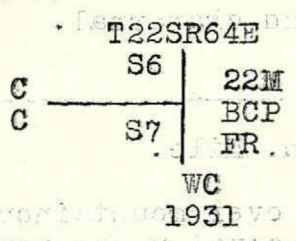
No timber.

Undergrowth, scattered creosote 1 to 4 ft. high and short shadscale, yellow top and chaparral.

North, on the 23rd. Mile.

Ascend over rough mountains land through creosote, shadscale, and chaparral undergrowth.

.67 On W. edge of high, rocky ridge bearing NW. and S.30°E., 275 ft. above draw to the S. Cement a brass tablet in hole drilled in solid rock for witness cor. to the 22nd. Mile Cor., and the closing cor. of secs. 6 and 7, T. 22 S., R.64 E., marked



.89 Raise a mound of stone, 10 ft. base, 7 ft. high, on line, 22 lks. N. of cor. From cor., high school building in Las Vegas, Nevada, bears N.64°54'W.; gypsum peak, bears N.30°40'W.; Charleston peak, bears N.72°31'W.

1.00 Edge of ledge, 120 ft. high, on face of butte on ridge, bears NW., E about 1 ch., then S.30°E.; descend abruptly.

13.85 Small spur, 335 ft. below ridge, projects N.5°W.; descend along broken E. slope.

32.25 Small draw, 140 ft. below spur, drains E.; ascend.

37.35 Top of ascent on E. slope, 65 ft. above draw, bears E. and W.; gradually descend.

40.00 On E. slope. Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in dia., 28 ins. in the ground for 22½ Mile Cor., with brass cap marked



raise a mound of stone, 4 ft. base, 3 ft. high, E. of cor.

From this cor., the ¼ sec. cor. bet. secs. 1 and 6, T. 22 S., Rs. 63½ and 64 E., bears West, 1.98 chs. distant; for description of cor. see Book "B", this group.

41.80 Head of small draw, 25 ft. below top of ascent, drains E. about 3 chs., then N.; ascend.

45.30 Point of rocky spur, 75 ft. above draw, projects N.5°E.; descend along rocky NW. slope.
