Chains	<p>Land, rolling bench and hills; general S. exposure and drainage.</p> <p>Soil, sandy clay, gravelly, and gypsum; 3rd. and 4th. rates.</p> <p>No timber.</p> <p>Undergrowth, creosote and shadscale.</p>
	<p>East, on the 38th. Mile, on a transit line describing the tangent, which bears S.89°57'E.</p> <p>Over rolling sandy bottom lands through scattered creosote and shadscale undergrowth.</p>
11.60	Small wash, 10 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, drains S.
36.40	Top of knoll, bears N. 1 ch. and S. about 4 chs. distant.
40.00	N. 22 lks. from the tangent.
	<p>Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in dia., 28 ins. in the ground for the 37½ Mile Cor., with brass cap marked</p> <p style="text-align: center;">37½ M BCFFR 1931</p> <p>raise a mound of stone, 4 ft. base, 3 ft. high, S. of cor.</p>
44.00	Low spur, 20 ft. above ½ mile cor., projects SE.
50.00	Draw, drains S.
53.50	Leave bottom lands, bear N. and S.; begin abrupt ascent over W. slope.
72.75	Ridge, 353 ft. above the 37½ Mile Cor., bears S., N. about 2 chs., thence NE.
73.20	Begin abrupt descent over E. slope.
75.65	Gulch, 125 ft. below ridge, drains SE.; ascend abruptly.
76.18	N. 26 lks. from the tangent; intersect E. bdy. of T.21 S., R.65 E., South, 1.94 chs. distant from the cor. of secs. 13, 18, 19, and 24; closing cor. for secs. 19 and 24 established at this point, for description of same see Book "B", this group.
77.95	Rocky spur, 80 ft. above gulch, projects SE.; descend E. slope over ledges and outcroppings, 165 ft. to
80.00	N. 26 lks. from the tangent.
	<p>Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. in dia., 18 ins. in the ground on solid rock and supported by a large mound of stone for the 38th. Mile Cor. and Cor. No.6 of the Reservation boundary, with brass cap marked</p>
