MEANDERS OF THE RIGHT BANK OF THE COLORADO RIVER, DOWN STREAM, IN UNSURVEYED T.23 S., R.65 E., M.D.M., FROM TRUE POINT FOR MEANDER COR. S. BDY. SEC. 32, T.22 S., R.65 E., to WITNESS COR. TO COR. NO.1 OF THE RESERVATION BOUNDARY.

From the true point for the meander cor. S. bdy. sec. 32, T.22 S., R.65 E., which is 95 lks. W. of the witness cor. to the meander cor. heretofore described,

Thence with meanders in T.23 S., R.65 E.

Note: From point of beginning, the meander cor. of secs. 10 and 15, T. 30 N., R.23 W., G. & S.R. Meridian, Arizona, bears N.17°43'E., 16.49 chs. distant; an iron post, 1 in. in dia., firmly set, and marked and witnessed as described in the official record.
