A mahogany, 10 ins. diam., bears S.  $24\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  E., 65 lks. dist., marked T 7 N R 29 E S 5 B T

No other trees suitable for bearing trees are available; raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, W. of cor.

From cor., an old shack covered with tin on E. side of bottom of S. Fork of Cat Creek Canyon, bears S.  $25\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  E., about 10 chs. distant.

Land, high and rough, mountains; E. exposure and SE. drainage into Cory Canyon on E. 48.75 chs., and general N. exposure and drainage into Cat Canyon on remainder of mile.

Soil, rocky, of granite formation; 4th. rate.

Timber, mahogany, pinon, and cedar.

Undergrowth, sagebrush, shadscale, bitter brush and weeds.

N.  $89^{\circ}28'$  W., bet. secs. 6 and 31.

Ascend SE. slope over rough mountainous land through scattered mahogany, cedar, and pinon timber and short undergrowth.

13.00 Spur, 210 ft. above sec. cor., projects NE. about 8 chs., then N.; enter medium growth of timber, thence along steep N. slope.

18.40 Head of draw, 15 ft. below spur, drains N.; ascend NE. and E. slopes 340 ft. to  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor.

40.03 The  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., which is a mahogany stake, about 4 ins. square and 4 ft. long, lying in an old mound of stone and marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  on one face.

At cor. point,

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 18 ins. in the ground on solid rock with original cor. monument standing alongside and supported by a large mound of stone for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap marked
