

SURVEY OF SECTION 31, T.9 N., R.31 E.

Chains

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 28 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap marked

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in dia., 28 ins. in the ground for closing cor. of secs. 30 and 31, T.9 N., R.31 E., with brass cap marked

raise a mound of stone, 4 ft. base, 3 ft. high, N. of cor.

45.90 Old road, bears N. and S.

53.15 Old road, bears N.10°E. and S.10°W.

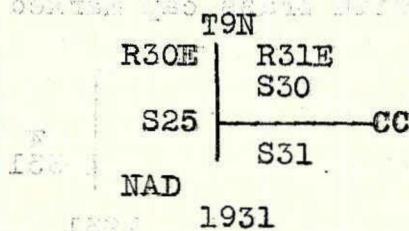
64.70 Wash, 10 lks. wide, 3 ft. deep, drains S.

70.70 Wash, 30 lks. wide, 4 ft. deep, drains S.20°W.

71.40 Road, bears N.30°E. and S.30°W.

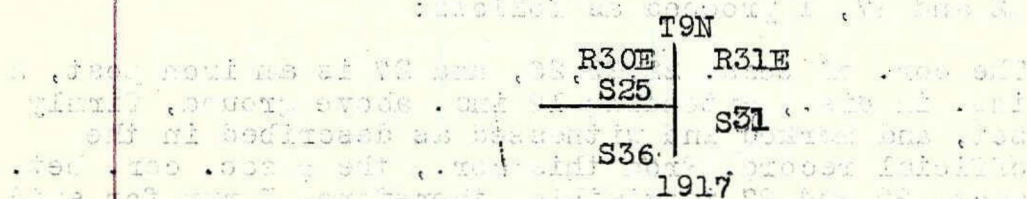
81.87 Intersect E. bdy. of T.9 N., R.30 E.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in dia., 28 ins. in the ground for closing cor. of secs. 30 and 31, T.9 N., R.31 E., with brass cap marked



raise a mound of stone, 4 ft. base, 3 ft. high, E. of cor.

From this cor. the cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31, and 36 on the boundary bears South, 5.56 chs. distant; an iron post, 2 ins. in diam., extending 10 ins. above ground, firmly set, and marked and witnessed as described in the official record. I remark this cor. so as to refer to secs. 25 and 36, T.9 N., R.30 E. only, as follows:



Land, gently rolling; general W. exposure and drainage.

Soil, deep loose sand and gravelly; 3rd. rate.

No timber.

Undergrowth, shadscale and sagebrush.
