

INDEPENDENT RESURVEY OF A PORTION OF THE SECOND STAN. PAR. N., THROUGH R. 46 E.

Chains

Soil, east $\frac{1}{2}$ mile fine light sandy clay loam and rocky; 3rd rate; west $\frac{1}{2}$ mile shallow sandy loam very rocky; 4th rate. Timber, pinon pine, juniper and mahogany; undergrowth, sagebrush, rabbitbrush and a sparse growth of native grasses.

West, along the S. bdy. of sec. 31.

Over mountainous land, through scattering timber and undergrowth; asc. 310 ft. along S. slope.

13.40 Top of ascent, slope changes to SW.; desc. 180 ft.

26.10 Trail Canyon Creek, 3 lks. wide, 2 ins. deep, clear water, course S. 80° E.; asc. 170 ft. along NE. slope.

33.20 Top of rocky knife edge spur, projects N.; desc. 110 ft.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for standard $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

45.80 Trail Canyon, course N. 70° E.; a small stream heads in canyon 8.00 chs. N. 70° E.; asc. 190 ft. over rugged SE. slope and series of ledges.

53.80 Top of ledge, 60 ft. high, facing E.; asc. 80 ft.

56.40 Rock ledge, projects from spur, asc. 10 ft.

58.10 Top of rocky spur, slopes S.; desc. 90 ft.

63.70 Gulch, course S. 10° E.; asc. 40 ft.

65.80 Top of spur, slopes S.; desc. 30 ft.

67.20 Gulch, course S. 70° E.; asc. 70 ft.

77.65 A point which is south of the original $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 30.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for standard cor. of Tps. 11 N., Rs. 45 and 46 E., with brass cap mkd.
