


SURVEY OF SUBDIVISIONAL LINES COMPLETING THE SUBDIVISION OF T. 11 N., R. 46 E.

Chains

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for closing cor. of secs. 30 and 31, with brass cap mkd.

A pinon pine, 4 ins. diam., bears N. $37\frac{1}{2}^\circ$ E., 64 lks. dist., mkd. B T only.

A pinon pine, 6 ins. diam., bears S. $46\frac{1}{2}^\circ$ E., 32 lks. dist., mkd. T 11 N R 46 E S 31 CC B T.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, shallow sandy loam, mixed with gravel and rocky; 3rd rate. Timber, pinon pine, juniper and mahogany; undergrowth, sagebrush and a fair growth of grass.

From the reestablished $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., bet. secs. 29 and 30.

South, bet. secs. 29 and 30.

Over mountainous land, through dense undergrowth and timber, asc. 90 ft.

- 7.40 Shoulder of spur, projects E.; desc. 30 ft.
- 10.80 Wash, drains N. 30° E.; asc. 60 ft.
- 15.50 Top of low spur, projects N. 70° E.; asc. 30 ft.
- 21.00 Small wash, drains E.; asc. 160 ft.
- 28.70 Top of spur, projects NE.; asc. 135 ft. over E. slope.
- 38.00 Top of spur, projects N. 60° E.; desc. 40 ft.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, shallow sandy loam, gravel and rocky; 3rd rate. Timber, pinon pine, juniper and mahogany; undergrowth, sagebrush and a fair growth of grass.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land in the interior of secs. 29, 30, 31 and 32 is of a mountainous and broken character, well watered, covered with pinon pine, juniper and mahogany timber of little commercial value; a dense growth of sagebrush and native shrubs and native grasses. The soil is shallow sandy loam, gravel and very rocky; 3rd rate. All drainage is toward Pine Creek and in a northeasterly direction. The north four miles of the W. bdy. of this township crosses numerous washes draining easterly in which the land is rolling mountainous in character. Nearly all of the area lies within the Toiyabe National Forest; and is used for grazing purposes.
