An aspen, 4 ins. diam., bears N. 46° E., 10 lks. dist., mkd. only B T.

An aspen, 4 ins. diam., bears S. 30° E., 27 lks. dist., mkd. only B T.

An aspen, 10 ins. diam., bears S. 42° W., 57 lks. dist., mkd. T 11 N R 47 E S 12 B T.

An aspen, 8 ins. diam., bears N. 71° W., 25 lks. dist., mkd. T 11 N R 47 E S 1 B T.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, shallow sandy loam and rocky; 3rd rate.

Timber, aspen, mahogany, pinon pine and juniper; undergrowth, sagebrush and a fair growth of grass.

North, bet. secs. 1 and 6.

Over mountainous land, through scattering timber and undergrowth, desc. 5 ft.

- 0.60 Spring branch, 4 lks. wide, 4 ins. deep, course SW.; desc. 10 ft.
- 2.90 Spring branch, 5½ lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, course S. 60° W.; asc. 70 ft.
- 7.60 Base of cliff, bears N. 60° E. and S. 60° W.; asc. abruptly 30 ft.
- 8.60 Top of rimrock; thence asc. 55 ft. over table land.
- 18.50 Top of ridge, bears E. and W.; desc. 55 ft.
- 28.90 Ravine, course W.; asc. 50 ft.
- 34.50 Top of spur, projects W.; desc. 45 ft.
- 40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 18 ins. in the ground to bed rock, with a limestone, 2x4x10 ins. mkd. X, deposited at the base, and in a mound of stone to top, for ¼ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

66.40 Top of rimrock, bears E. and W.; asc. 40 ft.

75.45 Intersect the N. bdy. at a point from which the original cor. of secs. 3, 4, 33, and 34, on the N. bdy., bears West, 232.05 chs. dist.
