

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for closing cor. of secs. 8 and 17, with brass cap mkd.

Land, rolling mountainous.

Timber, pinon pine, juniper and mahogany; undergrowth, sagebrush and a fair growth of grass.

From the cor. of secs. 7, 8, 17 and 18.

West, on true line bet. secs. 7 and 18,

Over rolling mountainous land, through dense timber and undergrowth, asc. 180 ft.

14.80 Top of spur, projects SE.; desc. 60 ft.

26.00 Ravine, course S.; asc. 210 ft.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 7 ins. in the ground to bedrock and in a mound of stone to top, for 1/4 sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.
