

of stone, 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, W. of cor. raise a mound

From this closing cor., the cor. of secs. 4 and 9, heretofore described, bears S. 0° 40' W., 4.22 chs. dist.

Land, rolling mountainous.
Soil, sandy loam, shallow and rocky; 3rd rate.
Timber, juniper and pinon pine; undergrowth, sagebrush and a fair growth of grass.

From the cor. of secs. 5, 6, 7 and 8.

West, on true line, bet. secs. 6 and 7.


Over rolling mountainous land, through scattering timber and dense undergrowth, asc. 90 ft.

10.00 Head of ravine, course S. 70° E.; asc. 460 ft.

28.00 Top of high rocky spur, projects N. 20° E.; desc. 80 ft.

36.60 Ravine, course N. 35° E.; asc. 90 ft.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 16 ins. in the ground to bedrock and in a mound of stone, for ¼ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.





From this closing sec. cor., the cor. of secs. 1 and 12, on E. bdy. T. 11 N., R. 48 E., heretofore described, bears North, 17.32 chs. dist.

Soil, sandy loam, shallow and rocky; 3rd rate.
Timber, pinon pine, juniper and mahogany; undergrowth, sagebrush and a fair growth of grass.
