Grazing, fair to poor.

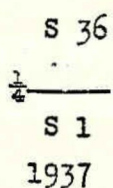
SURVEY OF THE N. BDY. OF T. 16 N., R. 45 $\frac{1}{2}$  E.

West, on true line bet. secs. 1 and 36.

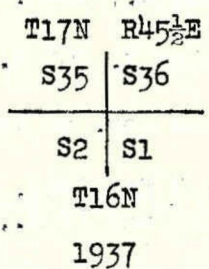
Over rolling land thru medium dense low undergrowth. Desc. 180 ft. over an irregular W. slope.

- 14.30 Drain, course S. 85° W.
- 15.40 Draw, drains S. 60° W.
- 22.60 Recross same draw, drains NW.; continue over a rolling N. slope.
- 33.20 Drain, course N.
- 40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 10 ins. in the ground to solid rock, with a sandstone 4x4x7 ins., mkd. X, deposited at the base, and in a mound of stone, 4 ft. base, to top of post, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

- 41.50 Minor spur, slopes N.
- 52.10 Drain, course N.
- 57.50 Minor spur, slopes N.; desc. 140 ft. over a general NW. slope.
- 80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36, with brass cap mkd.
