A pinon pine, 4 ins. diam., bears N. $45\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W., 59 lks. dist.,
mkd. T16NR46ES31SCBT.

Land, mountainous.

Timber, pinon pine, juniper, mahogany.

West, along S. bdy. of sec. 31.

21.40 Spur, slopes S. 50° W.; desc. 320 ft. over broken W. slope.

37.90 Sidehill drain, course S. 80° W.; continue along S. slope.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 16 ins. in the ground,
to solid rock and in a large supporting mound of stone to top of
post, for std. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

73.20 Watercourse in canyon bottom, 20 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, course N.,
asc. 210 ft. over abrupt E. slope.

80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground,
to solid rock and in a mound of stone to top of post, for std.
cor. of Ts. 16 N., Rs. $45\frac{1}{2}$ and 46 E., with brass cap mkd.
