

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF A PORTION OF THE 3RD STAN. PAR. N.,
THROUGH RANGE 47 E.

Chains

quartzite rock, 2x5x12 ins., lying on a small mound of earth and stones, mkd. $\frac{1}{2}$ on one face.

At the point for the cor., in center of mound

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 30 ins. in the ground, for angle point corner, with brass cap mkd.

At point for cor. in center of mound,

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with old cor. deposited at base of post, for angle point corner, with brass cap mkd.
