From the cor. of secs. 7, 12, 13 and 18 on the W. bdy. of the tp., previously described.

S. $88^{\circ} 02'$ E., on true line bet. secs. 7 and 18.

Over rolling land, through scattering low undergrowth; desc. 160 ft. over SE. and E. slopes to wash.

38.30 Dry wash, 12 ft. wide, 1 ft. deep, course N. 50° E.

39.09 Proportionate distance.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 30 ins. in the ground, with a porphyry rock, $2\frac{1}{2} \times 6$ ins., mkd. X, deposited at base of post, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

Undergrowth, sagebrush, white sage, greasewood.

No timber.

Grazing, fair.

COMPLETION OF THE SURVEY OF THE SUBDIVISIONS OF T. 16 N., R. 47 E.

From the cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36 on the W. bdy. of the Tp.

East, on true line, bet. secs. 30 and 31.

Over rolling land, through medium dense undergrowth; desc. 100 ft. over E. slope.

36.10 Draw, course SE.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 14 ins. in the ground, with a granite rock, $4\frac{1}{2} \times 6$ ins., mkd. X, deposited at base of post and in a large supporting mound of stone to top, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. with brass cap mkd.

63.70 Broad shallow wash, drains N. 70° E.

68.50 Old wood road, bears N. 50° W. and S. 70° E.

70.77 Intersect the W. bdy. of sec. 29.

At point of intersection,

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, with a porphyry rock, $3 \times 6 \times 9$ ins., mkd. X, deposited at base of post, for the closing cor. of secs. 30 and 31, with brass cap mkd.
