

## DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF THE SOUTH BDY. OF T. 19 N., R. 50 E.

Chains

80.51 Fall 04 lks. S. of the original cor. of secs. 4, 5, 32, and 33, hereinafter described.

The true course of the E. half mile is, therefore, S. 89°55' W. and the dist. is 40.21 chs.; the W. half mile is, therefore, N. 89°51' W. and the dist. is 40.30 chs.

Beginning at the original cor. of secs. 4, 5, 32, and 33. West, bet. secs. 5 and 32.

40.15 Fall 05 lks. S. of the original  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., hereinafter described.

80.41 Fall 05 lks. S. of the original cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31, and 32, hereinafter described.

The true course of the E. half mile is, therefore, N. 89°56' W. and the dist. is 40.15 chs.; the W. half mile is, therefore, West and the dist. is 40.26 chs.

Beginning at the original cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31, and 32. West, bet. secs. 6 and 31.

40.15 Fall 01 lks. N. of the original  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., hereinafter described.

70.34 Fall 43 lks. N. of the closing cor. of Tps. 18 N., Rs. 49 and 50 E., hereinafter described.

Continue same line and measurement along the S. bdy. of sec. 31.

78.06 Fall 43 lks. N. of the cor. of Tps. 19 N., Rs. 49 and 50 E., hereinafter described.

The true course of the E. half mile is, therefore, S. 89°59' W. and the dist. is 40.15 chs.; bet. the original  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. and the closing cor. of Tps. 18 N., Rs. 49 and 50 E. is S. 89°12' W. and the dist. is 30.19 chs.; and bet. the closing cor. and the cor. of Tps. 19 N., Rs. 49 and 50 E. is West and the dist. is 7.72 chs.

True Lines

Commence the resurvey at the original cor. of Tps. 18 and 19 N., Rs. 50 and 51 E., which is a juniper stake, 4 ins. sq., 2 ft. long, bearing illegible scribe mks. and lying on top of an old mound of earth.

At point for cor.,

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for cor. of Tps. 18 and 19 N., Rs. 50 and 51 E., with brass cap mkd.
