	North, bet. secs. 7 and 12.
	Over level valley floor, through medium dense undergrowth.
.30	Main dirt road, bears N. 15° E. to U. S. Highway No. 50 and S. 15° W. to Antelope Valley.
19.10	Unimproved road, bears N. 80° E. and S. 80° W.
30.80	Shallow dry wash, drains N. 40° E. Overflow water from Bartine's Ranch, a stream about 5 lks. wide and 4" deep, drains down this wash at intermittent periods.
35.70	Shallow, dry wash, drains NE.
40.00	Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 30 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

	Deposit a quart of broken glass at base of post.

70.70	Old stage road, Austin to Eureka, unimproved, bears N. 85° E. and S. 85° W.
80.00	Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 30 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7, and 12, with brass cap mkd.

	Deposit a quart of broken glass at base of post.
	Land, level valley floor. Soil, sandy to gravelly; 2nd rate. Undergrowth, black sage. Timber, none. Grazing, poor.

8.00	Wide, shallow wash, drains N. 85° E.
