Chains

Deposit a quart of broken glass at base of post.

79.25 The cor. of Tps. 19 and 20 N., Rs. 49 and 50 E., an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam., firmly set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the official record.

Land, rolling valley floor.  
Soil, sandy to gravelly; 3rd rate.  
Undergrowth, greasewood and black sage.  
Timber, none.  
Grazing, poor.


SUBDIVISION OF T. 19 N., R. 50 E.

Commence the subdivisional survey at cor. of secs. 35, and 36 on S. bdy. of the Tp., heretofore described.

N. 0°01' W., bet. secs. 35 and 36.

Over rolling valley floor, through medium dense undergrowth.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.



18x18x12 ins., N. and S. of post, 3 ft. dist. dig pits,

52.50 Low sand ridge, bears N. 15° W. and S. 15° E.

64.10 Unimproved road, bears N. 75° E. and S. 75° W.

80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 25, 26, 35, and 36, with brass cap mkd.

Land, rolling flat.  
Soil, sandy volcanic loam; 2nd rate.  
Undergrowth, black sage, rabbit brush.  
Timber, none.  
Grazing, poor.

N. 89°58' E., on a random line bet. secs. 25 and 36.

40.00 Set temp.  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor.

79.96 Intersect E. bdy. of Tp., 07 lks. N. of the cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31, and 36, heretofore described.

Thence,
