

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF W. BDY. T. 1 S., R. 35 E.

Chains

35 E., bears E. 33.97 chs. dist.; an iron post, 3 ins. diam., 12 ins. above ground, firmly set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the official record. From the same cor. the standard 1/4 sec. cor., S. bdy. sec. 36, T. 1 N., R. 34 E., bears W., 6.03 chs. dist.; an iron post, 1 in. diam., firmly set, and 10 ins. above ground, mkd. and witnessed as described in the official record.

Land, rolling and mountainous and broken. Soil, sandy, gravelly with much loose stone on surface; 4th rate. No timber; undergrowth, stunted sagebrush, greasewood, shadscale and a scant growth of native grasses.

REESTABLISHMENT OF SURVEYS EXECUTED BY HATCH, BARKER AND EATON, DEPUTY SURVEYORS, IN 1877

Beginning at the original cor. of secs. 3, 4, 33, and 34, on the S. bdy. of the Tp., which is a granite stone, 14x8x4 ins. above ground, firmly set in a mound of stone mkd. and described in the official record. All trace of pits have disappeared.

At point for cor.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, with original stone deposited alongside post, for cor. of secs. 3, 4, 33 and 34, with brass cap mkd.
