Land, rough mountainous.

Soil, rocky; clay loam; 4th rate.

Timber, scattered juniper.

Undergrowth, sagebrush and squaw brush.

Grazing, poor.

North, bet. secs. 1 and 6.

Over mountainous land, through scattering timber and undergrowth; desc. 205 ft. over a NW. slope.

7.40 Draw, drains SE.; asc. 170 ft. over a general S. slope.

17.70 Spur, projects N. 10° E.; desc. 340 ft. over a general N. slope.

39.00 Canyon, drains N. 10° W.; desc. 35 ft. along E. side of the canyon to the 49.60 ch. point.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 12 ins. in the ground to solid rock, and in a mound of stone, for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.
